Central Pennsylvania Region of Sports Car Club of America is proud to host Evolution Performance Driving School. The schools are scheduled for Saturday, May 3 and Sunday May 4, 2008, at Mid-State Airport, just 30 minutes from State College.

This will be Phase I only, which will be offered both days. We cannot give you a choice of days. Because both days are Phase I, we will fill Saturday first, and then fill Sunday, on a first-come-first-serve basis. Once both days are filled, you are free to trade days with other students, if they are willing, but both parties must inform us in advance. The maximum number of students per day is twelve (12), so be sure to get your registration in early to obtain the day you want. You must be an SCCA member to attend this school. If you have any questions about procedures or the event itself, contact Gary Gurchik at assistantre@scca-cpr.com.

This will be a full day and there will be a maximum of six students to each instructor. To receive the full benefit of the school, plan to be on site with your vehicle ready to go at 8:00 am. The vehicle must pass tech inspection. Car numbers will be assigned by us. The day will conclude with a de-briefing by your instructors and could last until 5:00 or 6:00 pm. Most students feel the de-briefing is as important as the on-track time.

Students must bring cars with two front seats so the instructors can ride with the students, and the students can ride with the instructors. The instructors have found from experience that learning and focus suffer greatly when dealing with single seat cars. Remember, the idea is to get the most from your time and money. It is also recommended that if your normal car is finicky, it would be best to bring a different car. The instructors point out that several mod car drivers have attended in rental cars and daily drivers and everything they learned directly translated over to their normal ride.

This school is to learn driving techniques and the more time you spend concentrating on driving, the more you will learn. The course and curriculum are uniquely designed to quickly reveal where you're good and where you need to concentrate. Instructors will ride with you in your car and you'll ride with them in order to assist you to get the most from your car and the most from yourself. The instructors also offer outside observation as they explain and show proven driving techniques. Also, at every future event that any of the instructors attend where the graduate of the school is present, the instructor's personal assistance and advice is available to them.

Students typically make 20 to 25 runs on an approximately 35 second course, therefore be sure you bring enough tires. Some students prefer to use street tires or older/longer lasting road race tires because of the high number of runs on the relatively tight course. Don't let this caution scare you off. The school courses are perfect for quick concise learning, but tire wear needs to be kept in mind due to the large number of runs. Keep in mind also, that students are required to work the course when they are not running, so there will probably be six students taking instruction while six work. Lunch will be provided.

The school will be filled on a first-come-first-serve basis. Saturday will be filled first, then Sunday. Once your check is received, Gary will contact you and let you know what day you are in. Gary will keep everyone informed, periodically on the Yahoo group site, on the status of how the days are filling.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If the school is held, a refund will be issued in the following cases IF there is a waiting list or the school has covered it's expenses: 1) Cancellation 30 days before an event, 100% refund 2) Cancellations 29-15 days before an event, 50% refund. 3) cancellations 15-2 days before the event, 25% refund. 4) No shows and no valid reason, 0% refund. Exception to this policy will only be made for compelling reasons.

If for any reason you cannot attend, every effort will be made to fill your spot from the waiting list (if any). If we cannot fill your spot, it will be up to you to find someone to buy your spot to recover any non-refunded portion of what you paid. The schools will be held regardless of weather conditions, just like autocrosses. If it rains or is wet, you will learn as much or more in the rain/wet weather, and tire wear will probably be significantly reduced.
