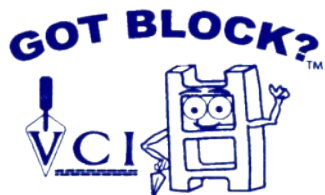




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NATIONAL SCCA NEWS

MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED FOR 2008

A topic of much discussion among SCCA membership lately has been a decision by the National SCCA organization to require all competitors to be SCCA members. The SCCA's reason for doing this is to increase membership and lower liability by bringing all competitors under their insurance coverage. The debate rages on over whether or not this requirement is good, as a whole, for the organization. Regardless of that debate, it appears that the requirement will go in to effect on January 1, 2008.

However, the SCCA has implemented a Weekend Membership to compensate for this program. This will allow non-members to continue to compete without paying for a full year's membership. The Central PA Region has not yet decided how this will affect our entry fees.

The Northeast Division SCCA has provided some information about the membership requirement and the Weekend Membership, which can be found below.

Why?

- Supports the SCCA mission to provide events and activities for members.
- Membership is the lifeblood of the organization for participants and leaders.
- Protection of SCCA and contestants with \$1,000,000 excess medical coverage.

What are the program components?

- Effective January 1, 2008 all competitors are required to be a SCCA Regular (includes Individual, Spouse, Family, First Gear, Lifetime and Military) or Weekend Member.
- The face value for Weekend Membership is \$15. The face value may be applied toward annual membership for sixty days. The maximum amount that may be applied is \$30.

Benefits

Region:

- Structured and sustainable recruitment program
- Potential for future leaders and/or active members
- Additional benefits for non-members.

SCCA:

- Partial funding for recruitment program
- Membership gains strengthens the Club
- Legal umbrella

Weekend Member:

- Membership discount (coupon)
- Insurance coverage
- Sense of belonging

MEETING MINUTES - October 9, 2007

Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm at Damon's. Present were, David Mohar (RE), Gary Gurchik (Ass't RE), Lauren Mohar (Treasurer), Ron Dotts, Mike Cunningham, Steve Lower, Steve Shuss, Steve Eastman, Nate Coraor, Jason Klingler, Deb Weaver, Aaron Eberhard, Charles Faris, Dave Kraige, Mike Sember, Vance Hensler, Rob Beck, Jon and Shaundra (daughter) Dershimer, Chuck Carroll

RE Report: No report.

Competition: Steve and Ryan Lower competed at Misery Bay in Erie. Steve spoke highly of that region. Ryan won first place and FTD. Ron Dotts, Dave Kraige, Jon Claypool, Keith Hoover, Don Wilson and Lee Watson competed in Cumberland and represented CPR well. Ron Dotts, Bruce Stevens, Mike Cunningham, and Rob Beck competed in Frackville, while Bryan Smith and Jeremy McCauley joined the crowd and provided transport for Rob Beck's car (and hosted a nice lunch too).

Secretary: Minutes of the September meeting were presented to the members present.

Treasurer: Current fund balance is \$21,083.27. This includes two \$5,000 Certificates of Deposit. Some discussion of other investment alternatives such as more competitive CD's and money market accounts. Lauren will look into competing rates available.

Solo:

Final Event Coming Up: Dave Mohar reported that, as our final event approaches, we appreciate all the extra help we have been getting at recent events and things have become much smoother.

Newsletter: Dave indicated that a newsletter will be out as his time permits and again solicited help. Nate offered to assist with layout if Dave and others would provide the data and articles.

Ron Dotts went to the bathroom

Membership: No current report available but was estimated by Dave at "over 100".

Merchandising: A decision was made to give free 2007 t-shirts to all who attended all four Fall Events. Older t-shirts will be given away also, possibly at our banquet. Some discussion of possibly offering CPR helmet bags for sale next year as we feel they would sell well.

Sponsorship: No updates. Some discussion of just having the top three sponsors on trophy glasses and having all the sponsors on t-shirts. This may depend on how sponsorship will be structured next year and also on what style trophies we use next year.

Website: A merchandising page was recently added. It was suggested that a contact person be added to that page (preferably an officer), as the person to contact if anyone wants to purchase merchandise over the off-season.

Old Business:

Assistants to Chairpersons: Charlie working on producing a Word document to be updated progressively as additional job descriptions become available.

Witches Rallye: Dave will be the Safety Steward for the event and will review the course with Nate. Nate indicated the appropriate sanctions are in place.

Supplementals: Steve presented revised update based on input from the previous meeting. Some discussion of the "Competition Rules and Site Regulations", under Non-Competition Runs, the last sentence highlighted. There was some concern voiced that we should not formally require non-comp drivers to help in clean-up. Nate motioned that the Supplementals be approved, after eliminating that sentence. Mike Cunningham seconded. Motion passed.

Police Challenge/Drivers Challenge: Both events went extremely well and we appreciated the good attendance from Pa State Troopers.

Cone Killer Classic Logo: Steve is working with Carmine Prestia on the procedure as this individual has experience in this area. Steve will develop more information but has found out that there is a different procedure for non-profit organizations. He will continue to work on it.

Nominations: Charlie distributed a report of members desiring nomination which includes: Steve Lower for RE; Ron Dotts and Ryan Lower for Secretary. Also indicated persons willing to serve as chairpersons: Ron Dotts and Bryan Smith as Solo Chair. Charlie encouraged people to step forward. Each member desiring to hold office will be given five minutes to state their case at the November meeting and again just before elections in December.

Cone Killer Classic 2008: Ron indicated that he will ask a nationally recognized individual such as Sam Strano to design the course for next year. He also suggested that we hold off making the dates official until we know the schedules of surrounding regions and national events.

Road Cruises: No progress.

Video for Rally Training: Dave will work with Nate and Aaron on an agreed date to produce the video. Will try to produce on the Saturday before the final event.

2008 Year End Awards Points System: Ron will join the team of Dave, Charlie, Barry and Lauren to review and suggest changes to the points system for 2008. The committee will meet sometime in November.

Rallycross: Will be deleted from the winter schedule as no one has stepped forward to organize it. **New Timing Software/Finish Line Printout:** Ron passed around his "finish line printouts" from Cumberland as an example of what we could have if we purchased the equipment. Nate will take charge of coordinating new timing equipment and software replacement for 2008, including a finish line printout system. He will solicit a group to explore the options available. Vance Hensler also offered to work with Nate on writing a program for timing/finish software.

Hillclimb: Off the agenda until we have further information or indication of more interest.

Awards Banquet: The banquet will be held February 9, 2008 at Toftrees. There was some discussion of entree choices and offering two free bar drinks or reduced price for banquet. A decision was made to go with the three entree option and no free alcoholic beverages and the price will be \$17.50 per attendee.

2008 Membership Requirement: There was some discussion of the new National rule that all competitors be SCCA members beginning in 2008. This would include a special "Weekend Membership" plan for those who are not currently members and the proposed cost would be \$15 additional to the non-member over and above the member event fee. CPR would have flexibility in assessing this fee and further discussion will follow at future meetings as more information becomes available.

Van clean-up and winterize: After the last event of the season, the van needs to be cleaned up and winterized. A decision was made to schedule this for Sunday, November 4 at 11:00 am. Ron, Steve Lower, Nate, Dave Kraige, Gary, Lauren, Charlie, and Steve Shuss all volunteered. We think that may be enough.

Adjournment: There being no further business, at 8:45 pm, a motion to adjourn was made by Nate, and seconded by Mike. Motion passed.

Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 7:10 pm at Damon's. Present were, David Mohar (RE), Gary Gurchik (Ass't RE), Lauren Mohar (Treasurer), Ron Dotts, Mike Cunningham, Steve Lower, Ryan Lower, Steve Eastman, Aaron Eberhard, Charles Faris, Dave Kraige, Mike Sember, Vance Hensler, Rob Beck, Chuck Carroll, Tom Tremper, Bernie Betzema (sorry if I got that wrong).

RE Report: .No report.

Competition: Mike and Rob gave a detailed report on a trip to Nelson's Ledges that included Mike, Rob Beck, Bryan Smith, Chuck Carroll, and Andy Bower of the Northeast Region. It sounded like a great trip and lots of fun. Much discussion of the event and how it worked and lots of questions about car prep, requirements, etc. Photos can be found on Chuck Carroll's website chuckcarrollphotography.com. Ron Dotts, Keith Hoover and Karl Bender attending the two-day Hershey event in October. A great course and venue, Ron said it was his best day ever autocrossing.

Secretary: Minutes of the October meeting were presented to the members present. After review and short discussion, a motion was made by Mike and seconded by Ryan to approve the minutes as presented.

Treasurer: Current fund balance is \$21025.80. This includes two \$5,000 Certificates of Deposit. It was agreed that, because the final event was cancelled, those holding a free coupon intended for that event would be allowed to use it in a 2008 event.

Solo:

Because the final event was cancelled, it was decided that the number of Fall events required for trophy position is two instead of three. And that all those completing three Fall events will get a free t-shirt.

Newsletter: David indicated that the newsletter is completed, subject to some minor changes and will be out shortly.

Membership: Based on October numbers, there are 117 members with three new members.

Merchandising: Gary indicated that he has possession of all the merchandise and it's being stored at his home. The website is to be updated to indicate that Gary is the person to be contacted if anyone wishes to purchase any merchandise during the off-season.

Sponsorship: Aaron indicated that he would update the Sponsorship Brochure. Gary will get a copy or computer file of the latest version of the brochure to Aaron.

Website: Website is to be updated to indicate that anyone wishing to purchase merchandise during the off-season should contact Gary, listing his contact information. It was noted that there is now a link on the home page to Chuck Carroll's photography website.

Old Business:

Assistants to Chairpersons: Charlie working on producing a Word document to be updated progressively as additional job descriptions become available.

Witches Rallye: Charlie indicated that the event went off smoothly, was a nice, interesting course, and a good time was had by all and that Nate did a good job in chairing the event. There were 19 competitors. Lauren said there was a huge contribution of goods to the State College Food Bank during the event, which is greatly appreciated by the club and the food bank. Lauren stated that Nate indicated that he would definitely not be interested in chairing the event next year. Lauren also indicated that Paul Stinson may be interest and David will contact him. A \$36 profit was made.

This does not include a \$100 donation to be made to United Way. A motion was made by Chuck and seconded by Mike that we proceed to make the donation regardless of profits. Motion passed.

New Business:

Cone Killer Classic Trademark: Steve indicated that we could simply put the tm indicator on the logo but if someone else were to register it, then we would have to stop using it. Also said that the fee for the trademark registration is \$375, which could be done separately for the words, logo, and artwork, or just as one. Separately would be \$375 each but could be done as one for a total of \$375. Ron indicated that the registration is very worthwhile and money well

spent. Some discussion of using Bryan Smith's attorney to pursue it, as we should not try to do it without legal counsel. Chuck made a motion to authorize the Board to spend up to \$1,500 to pursue the registration, Mike seconded and motion passed.

Nominations: Charlie distributed a report of members desiring nomination which includes: Steve Lower for RE; Dan Warner for Assistant RE; Ron Dotts and Ryan Lower for Secretary. Incumbent officers David Mohar (RE), Gary Gurchik (Ass't RE), and Lauren Mohar (Treasurer) have all indicated they are running for re-election. Steve Lower, Ron Dotts, Ryan Lower, and Lauren Mohar each gave a brief presentation regarding their desire to hold office. Ron Dotts has indicated his desire to serve as Solo Chair for 2008. No one else has offered to serve as chairperson(s) in any capacity. Charlie encouraged people to step forward. Each member desiring to hold office will be given five minutes to state his or her case at the December meeting. Mike brought up the issue of tie votes at the Board level, regarding a member being both an officer and committee chair. Current policy is that the Solo Chair votes as a tiebreaker in the event the four member Board has a tie. If Ron becomes the Solo Chair then it's not right that he votes twice. Steve suggested that a board member simply not be permitted to vote twice and that alternate Chairpersons be selected. David suggested that the Nominations Committee Chair be the tiebreaker or alternatively an odd number of chairpersons as tiebreakers. The issue was not resolved. Some consideration will be made to pairing down the number of chairpersons for next year.

Cone Killer Classic 2008: Ron indicated that he would like to set up the committee by January or February at the latest. He'll be asking for participants in the upcoming meetings.

Road Cruises: Steve indicated that he is not actively pursuing it because of lack of interest. If anyone has any ideas, the subject can be revisited.

Video for Rally Training: Aaron indicated that he is late in getting the video completed because of work assignments but he will do so as quickly as possible.

2008 Year End Awards Points System: A committee made up of Dave, Charlie, Ron and Lauren to review and suggest changes to the points system for 2008. The committee will meet sometime prior to January 1.

New Timing Software/Finish Line Printout: Aaron, Vance, and Mike Sember discussed plans to write new software for the timing equipment to directly interface with the computer. They have asked that they be given the operations manual for the current system to determine their ability to update it. Ron confirmed that this is all being coordinated with Nate. Ron also asked for assurance that we were not creating something that may be too complex for someone else to pickup and maintain and use; and also to confirm we have a timetable to implement by the first 2008 event.

The group confirmed this. They also indicated that it would easily interface with the planned finish line printout equipment.

Awards Banquet: The banquet will be held February 9, 2008 at Toftrees. Children may attend free of charge. Banquet registration form is available online and should be submitted to Gary no later than January 20.

2008 Membership Requirement: Some discussion of a new National rule that all competitors be SCCA members beginning in 2008. There is no new information on this but some believe that it is not yet official.

Water Donations: Steve Eastman said he would look into getting water donations as his wife works for a water bottling company.

2008 Season Scheduling: Ron suggested that we try to hold off on setting the 2008 schedule so as to try to coordinate with NEPA and Susquehanna. Gary indicated that he did so last year and will do so again this year.

Adjournment: There being no further business, at 8:55 pm, a motion to adjourn was made by Ryan, and seconded by Mike. Motion passed.
