

NOVEMBER 8, 2005 MEETING MINUTES

Call to Order: Dave Mohar (RE), Gary Gurchik (Asst RE), Lauren Mohar (Treasurer), Josh Duvall, Lee Watson, Bill Cunningham, Paul Stinson, Toby Mordkoff, Ron Dotts

Competition: Ron Dotts, Keith Hoover, Don Wilson, and Park Wiker gave a strong showing at Susquehanna Region Hershey event on October 23 with Keith and Don winning their classes and Ron and Park coming in second. Keith Hoover stretched the season one more event and placed second at the Philadelphia Region's Ripken Stadium event on October 30.

Secretary: Move to table

Treasurer: Current balance is \$11,057. Paul Stinson suggested that we consider doing something extra at the awards banquet because we had such a great year and solid cash balance. Ron Dotts suggested possibly upgrading year-end trophies as part of that.

Solo II: No Chair report. There was a general discussion of classes and classing. It was pointed out that it is up to the driver to indicate his/her class, and not the job of the registration desk. It is up to the other drivers to challenge the class of competitors if they feel a vehicle has been miss-classified. In an effort to make full disclosure of classes it was decided that for the 2006 season, all drivers will be required to display their class on their car with appropriate identifiers such as vinyl letters or on their number cards. It will be the responsibility of the competitor, not the registration desk, to do this. Further, it was decided that there will be a class listing posted on the side of the van immediately after registration closes so that all drivers have an early opportunity to challenge. Anyone can lodge a protest anytime after awards.

Newsletter: Newsletter will publish several days after the November meeting due to important input coming from the November meeting. A suggestion was made by Ron Dotts that NewSprint go to a 9 edition publication for 2006. Dave Mohar agreed this was acceptable.

Membership: Current membership is 94 with the Wiker family being the newest members.

Merchandising: Ron Dotts suggested having a t-shirt with logos and just the primary sponsor. Dave felt it was important that all sponsors be recognized on the t-shirts. Toby and others suggested possibly adding a polo shirt with the primary sponsor. Further discussion developed around possibly adding merchandising inventory such as car decals.

Old Business:

Witches Rally had 38 vehicles and 113 entrants with a staff of 12. Members donated much food and \$85 cash to Centre County Food Bank. Paul motioned to have CPR matched the cash contributions. Lauren seconded the motion and suggested adding enough to make the total cash contribution an even \$200. Motion was approved. Paul indicated that he would like someone else to do the Witches Rally next year and he would return the following year. State Police Challenge was very successful and enjoyed by all. A letter was received from Tim Shannon of the Pa State Police thanking us for the opportunity and hoping to do it again next year. Ron Dotts is to send a copy of that letter to the National Office.

New Business:

Officer Nominations: The nominating committee is the existing officers and all are accepting renomination except the position of Secretary. Dave Mohar nominated Ron Dotts for the position. Ron Dotts accepted the nomination. Josh Duvall expressed interest in the position as well.

Winter Rallycross: The site location of last year's Winter Rallycross is in jeopardy for this year's events due to possible zoning issues. It was recommended that we seek another location for the 2006 events.

Awards Banquet: Invitations will be mailed to all CPR members. Ron Dotts will download name list from the National Office.

Insurance: No further discussion.

Pre-Registration: Toby and Ron will work together to initial and set up pre-registration on MyAutoEvents.Com.

Northeast Division Convention: Ron Dotts will attend the convention held the weekend of November 11.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Dave Mohar to adjourn, which was seconded by Paul Stinson.
